- Print clearly. Illegible information could result in application being rejected.
- Submit only one application. More than one application per individual will result in disqualification.
- Select each area only once. Listing an area more than once does not change your odds of being drawn.
- <u>Awarded permits are non-transferable.</u> You may only receive one public land permit each season, either a State Wildlife Area, Federal National Wildlife Refuge or a State Forest permit.
- If selected, failure to accurately complete and return the Division-provided Turkey Harvest survey card after the season will result in disqualification from the lottery in the following year.
- All first-time Delaware Turkey Hunters must have satisfactorily completed a Division-approved Turkey Hunting Safety Course to be eligible to apply for a permit. (Note: Youth under the age of 13 that will be directly supervised while hunting by a person 21 years or older that has completed the class are exempt.)
- All applicants will be reviewed to confirm the successful completion of the required turkey hunting safety course before being considered for the lottery. <u>If not already verified</u>, applicants are also required to submit proof of course completion by the application deadline.
